Dining Options

There are multiple dining options within 2 to 3 blocks of the downtown Marriott, ranging from basic street food to sandwiches and casual food to fine dining. These are some suggestions, but this is not a comprehensive guide. Some places take reservations, and you can check the website of any you are interested in. Inside the Marriott:

Plough - 1st floor of the hotel. Varied menu with sandwiches as well as full entrees

The Exchange- rooftop full bar with light menu. Great views! Need to take the elevator up from the second tower.

Nearby (easy walk)- listed by approximate distance from the Marriott.

Lancaster Central Market. Across the square. Mostly produce, but some prepared foods around lunchtime.

Southern Market Food Hall. A variety of vendors open around lunchtime and evening. - lots of variety. 100 S. Queen Street, corner of Queen and Vine. Casual.

Barberet. Fine dining. 26 East King Street. Also has a rooftop bar and night club. Good food.

Tellus 360. Pub- 24 East King Street. Rooftop restaurant. Mostly pub food. Live music most weekend evenings.

Annie Bailey's. Irish Pub atmosphere and food. 28 East King Street.

Subway. Subs, etc. 19 E. King Street.

Isaac's Grilled Sandwiches. Casual. 25 N. Queen Street. Lunch and dinner.

Issei Noodle. 44 N. Queen Street. Vietnamese

The Pressroom. 26 West King Street. Indoor seating or outdoor with fountain at back of Steinman Park.

Shot & Bottle. 2 N. Queen St., right across the square from the Marriott. Casual food.

C'Est La Vie. 18 N. Market St. next to Central Market. Bistro. Indoor & outdoor.

Josephine's. 50 W. Grant St., behind Central Market. French cuisine- fine dining.

Yorgo's. Bar and lounge with mostly Greek food. Corner of N. Queen and W. Orange Streets.

Himalayan Curry and Grill. Nepalese and Indian Food. 22 East Orange Street. Lunch and dinner.

Citronelle. French style food. 110 West Orange Street. Dinner only.

On Orange. 108 W. Orange St. Breakfast and lunch.

Lancaster Dispensing Company. 33 N. Market St. Craft beers and pub grub. Live music sometimes.

Prince Street Café. 15 N. Prince Street. Light fare. Breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Cocina Mexicana. 47 N. Prince Street. Mexican food. Open for lunch and dinner.

Old San Juan. Puerto Rican and Latin food. 201 W. Orange Street.

Zoetropolis Cinema Stillhouse Restaurant. 112 N. Water St. American food

Imperial Restaurant. Inside the recently renamed Holiday Inn. Full menu. 26 East Chestnut Street.
